Gloves when necessary. • Walking or slow riding the route before riding at speed. • Good progressive training. • Control of speed and good briefing • Constant supervision of group • Maintenance of Braeside bikes and checking of children's bikes on arrival. • Protective equipment / glasses/ goggles if necessary • Single file riding on the Braeside track and in narrow areas. • Keep a safe distance from the riders in front. • Awareness of others, members of the public, dogs, farm animals, horses etc • Ride on soft terrain where possible and especially where falling is likely. • Qualified leaders in charge – MIAS • Leaders at the front and the rear of the group • First Aid kit and mobile phone to be carried at all times. <p>Please also see route finding RA for navigation etc</p>	<p>Check all pupils are in control of their bike / riding</p> <p>Extra care in summer /dry conditions when ground is hard.</p> <p>Check also p30 -32 MIAS Log book</p>
