Secondary pupils may work on their own providing they have a way of contacting their group leader.</li> <li>• Use pedestrian crossings whenever possible or adults stop traffic to allow groups to cross.</li> <li>• Clear instructions to pupils to raise awareness /problems</li> <li>• Leaders have knowledge of area including location of public phones /mobiles to be carried</li> <li>• Fluorescent jackets to be worn if poor visibility</li> <li>• First aid kit for each group</li> <li>• Mobile phones carried for emergencies</li> <li>• Yr 5 &amp; 6 may in the market area work in pairs with adult nearby at a set meeting point</li> <li>• Confirmed meeting points, end time and protocol arranged with staff</li> <li>• All groups to have Braeside telephone number</li> </ul>
